All Junior & Novice classes will drive the NOVICE TEST 2010. **ALL** other classes will drive the OPEN TEST 2010.

Arena 2. 08.30hrs	Novice Horse - Novice Pony
Arena 1. 12.30hrs approx.	Obstacles 3 & 4 ALL Open classes.

18.30/19.00hrs approx. Saturday evening, for your entertainment.

Area Knockout Challenge, run similar to the Indoor World Cup. This should be exciting with some of the fastest obstacle driving competitors representing their Area. ALL proceeds from this Challenge will go towards the GB Team going to Hungary for the World Young Drivers Championship in the summer.
